ABOUT GEORGE SCHOOL

George School is a boarding and day school for grades nine through twelve located in a suburban neighborhood 35 miles north of Philadelphia. The school's identity as a Quaker school is manifested most clearly in its desire to provide a quality education to students of diverse backgrounds, abilities, and interests in a community that values fairness, integrity, and concern for others. The curriculum includes an emphasis on academics, athletics, arts, and community service projects.

THE ANDERSON SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Anderson Scholarship program began in 1996 through the generous donation of a member of the class of 1950. The scholarship will provide four \$15,000 scholarships to new boarding students regardless of their economic level. Anderson Scholarships will be awarded each year that students attend George School provided they continue to demonstrate the qualities for which the award is given. Recipients will have proven their capacity for excellence in the areas listed below. Each will be weighed equally.

1. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Students must have at least a B+ average.

2. COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Students should have served others in their schools, religious institutions, or community organizations.

3. POTENTIAL FOR LEADERSHIP

Anderson Scholars should be role models who exhibit a positive attitude, concern for others, and respect for the rules and values of the school.
