

# PARENT PERMISSION FORM FOR SERVICE TRIPS SPRING AND SUMMER 2010



I understand that my child will have an opportunity to enter into a random selection process in order to participate in a service trip, and that I must approve (by September 22, 2009) any service trip for which s/he would like to be considered. I also understand that while service trip grants are offered to those students who receive financial aid for their tuition, these grants only cover ten to fifty percent of the cost of a service trip. In addition, I am aware that by October 5, 2009, my child must also turn in a separate essay/application for each project in which s/he is interested.
