

Parent Permission Form for Service Trips Spring and Summer 2012



I understand that my child will have an opportunity to enter into a random selection process in order to participate in a service trip, and that I must approve (by September 20, 2011) any service trip for which s/he would like to be considered. I also understand that while service trip grants are offered to those students who receive financial aid for their tuition, most grants only cover ten to fifty percent of the cost of a service trip, however, a few may cover more. In addition, I am aware that by October 3, 2011, my child must also submit a separate essay/application for each project in which s/he is interested.
